





Dr. Edwards returned to Howard in July 2016 as the first woman in the history of architectural education at the University to be elevated to the rank of full professor and to lead the Department of Architecture, College of Engineering and Architecture.




Sara Goins- Director of Marketing, Floura Teeter Landscape Architects
